Meat: Scavenging and Hunting. Chimpanzees hunt small primates and nonprimate mammals, but only occasionally, and meat is a minor component of their diet (120, 147). In contrast, meat is a critical food resource for modern human hunter-gatherers, along with plant foods (17, 36, 101, 136, 146). The earliest evidence for meat-eating in hominins dates to ~2.5 Mya ().

### Evolutionary Adaptations to Dietary Changes

Some ecologists study this phenomenon, and the possible effects it could have on the biome. Other ecologists study human behavior, where it came from, and the evolutionary pressures that lead to it.
